Christ Church, St Kilda, an historic parish founded in 1854 under the influence of the world-wide Tractarian Movement, is seeking to appoint a well-qualified and experienced organist who is also a pianist.

The organist-pianist would need to be available to play at liturgies appropriate to Christmas, Easter and other special occasions, as well as at weddings and funerals.
