



About the Role

Children & Youth Minister: St Luke's Frankston.

Part Time: (3 days).

We are looking for a Children and Youth Minister to join our team as we pursue our Vision 'to see the City of Frankston transformed by the hope of the Risen Lord'.

Three key priorities in this role are:

1. Review the discipleship/integration pathway for children and youth and ensure that our ministry responds to the whole child/youth (social, economic, educational, health and mental health needs, and certainly their spiritual need to trust in Christ).
2. Refocus our ministry pathway for children, youth, and their families, to better engage with disadvantaged children and youth in our setting (Frankston East, Frankston Central, Frankston North etc).
3. Expand the children and youth volunteer base to better reflect the disadvantage in our setting, and through them expand our reach into this setting.

A background in social work, community development, or the education of children and youth with neurodiversity or mental health struggles, will assist the successful applicant in addition to ministry/theology training.

About St Luke's Frankston

We have an established ministry pathway to children and youth which includes a mobilised volunteer team and established programs. In our children and youth ministries we presently have a reach of about 30 families. We have established links with a local primary school. At St Luke's we hold to the Bible first, then the shared Creeds of the Church and an evangelical and charismatic theological perspective. We express this in our Values: we value the Lord Jesus Christ; our unity in Christ; the way of discipleship- a different path from either cheap grace or legalism; the Spirit's empowering presence; we value the City of Frankston.
